1. IDENTIFICATION

Commercial Name: Liquid Leaf (various colours) Treasurer Sealer Brush Bath
Usage: Metallic Paint with Sealer and Brush Cleaner / Thinner.

2. COMPOSITION

Xylene (70% in volume per 35m1 bottle)
Liquid with a characteristic aromatic odour

Other Name: Xylol CAS Number 1330-20-7

4. REACTIVITY DATA

Hazard Decomposition and Combustion products:

Burning will produce heavy black heavy smoke, carbon monoxide and carbon monoxide.

Conditions to avoid:

Heat and open flames

5. FIRST AID MEASURES

Eyes: Immediately wash out with copious amounts of water for at least 10 minutes holding the eye open. Obtain medical attention.
Skin: Wash off with soap and water. Contaminated clothing should be washed before re-use.
Ingestion: Wash out mouth with water, keep warm and at rest. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. If there is difficulty in breathing, give oxygen. Obtain medical attention urgently.
Inhalation: Remove from exposure - keep warm and at rest. If there is difficulty in breathing give oxygen.
